EXISTING RULE

Grading

10.21 A student repeating a course in which a grade of B or better has been earned will not receive grade points for the repeated course, unless the catalog states the course may be repeated for credit.

RULE WITH PROPOSED CHANGES

Grading

10.21 A student repeating a course **completed at Texas A&M University** in which a grade of B or better has been earned will not receive grade points for the repeated course, unless the catalog states the course may be repeated for credit.

JUSTIFICATION

The proposed rule change is recommended by the AOC Deans following discussion in March 2013. This change specifies that the limitation on grade points for repeated courses only applies to courses completed at Texas A&M University. Students retaking courses completed at other institutions would be able to receive grade points regardless of the grade earned at the other school.
