Rule change proposals that are the same or similar to other proposals that have been submitted within the academic calendar year will be returned to the submitter with an explanation from the Chair.
 - Rule change proposals that are submitted on the same topic but support different changes to the verbiage of the rule, will move forward to the entire committee for review.
