18. Payment of Fees and Charges

(Revised: 2005)

18.1 Students are required to pay tuition, fees and charges to the university when due. Failure to do so may result in:

18.1.1 The student's being administratively withdrawn and removed from the rolls of the university with loss of credit for academic work performed that semester.

18.1.2 Assessment of a reinstatement fee.

18.1.3 < Removed 10/25/2005>

18.1.4-<u>3</u> Denial of future registration in the university until all past due balances, including late charges and reinstatement, fees are paid.

18.1.5 Denial of an official Texas A&M transcript until all past due balances, including late charges and reinstatement fees, are paid.

18.1.6-4 Removal from on-campus housing.

18.1.7–5 Disclosure of the delinquent debt to any credit bureau, collection agency or attorney.

18.1.8-<u>6</u> Assessment of amounts actually incurred by the university as court costs, attorneys' fees, and reasonable cost for collection.
