24.5 Bias-Related Violations

Student Rule 24.5 Change for Consideration

Proposed Change: It is proposed to amend **Student Rule 24.5** to include the red-lined text:

24.5. **Bias-Related Violations**—Violations of 24.4 of this Student Conduct Code that are motivated by prejudice toward a person or group because of factors such as race, religion, ethnicity, disability, national origin, age, gender or sexual orientation *may* be assessed an enhanced *sanction* as prescribed in section 27 of this publication. **This rule may only be applied by the office responsible for managing Civil Rights cases involving student respondents.**
