5.2. Change of Curriculum

Student Rule 5.2: Change of Curriculum

...

5.2 Most undergraduate students in their first term of full admission and enrollment at Texas A&M University may initiate a curriculum change before the end of the fifth (5th) day of regular classes. Curriculum changes may once again be initiated after final grades have posted as described in Section 5.1. Students admitted to a program in the College of Performance, Visualization and Fine Arts where an audition or portfolio review was required may not request a change of curriculum until the completion of one long semester in their admitted program.
