With the increase of tele-health appointments and documentation, there needs to be clarity that documentation must be verifiable (Section 7.3.1.1) for the absence to be considered excused. Additionally, several colleges/schools have reported students using a note from a doctor- to miss one class/activity but not another on the same day Section (7.3.1.5).
