13. Classification

(Revised: 2013 2019)

13.1 Classification for academic purposes shall be based solely on scholastic progress as shown by the official records in the registrar's office.

13.1.1 Scholastic progress for undergraduate students is defined as the number of hours successfully completed toward the student's primary degree.

13.1.2 Sophomore, junior and senior classification will be granted students who have passed 30, 60 and 95* 90 semester hours respectively.

* Beginning Fall 2009, Senior classification will be granted to students who have passed 90 semester hours. See **Recent Rule Changes** for details.
