1.5.1. Student Registration

1.5.1 A student is expected to register for a schedule of courses that follows the program of study for a degree in their college degree and/or certificate program they are enrolled in in which they are enrolled. A student who elects not to follow the program of study must obtain approval from their academic advisor, department head or college **Dean or designee**, and the Dean or designee of the college offering the courses. A student who fails to obtain approval may be, by their Dean or designee, held from registration, removed from the inappropriate course(s) and/or required to register for a prescribed schedule of courses.
